
A message from Shane:

1 Average Grant Amount: **\$3,853**



2 66% of recipients live in low to moderate income households

Tech- Cessibility:

Provides assistive technology grants to the disability community

1 Average Grant Amount: **\$2,610**

2 83% of recipients live in low to moderate income households



Emergency Relief Fund: Provides fast, essential support to people with disabilities facing urgent financial or equipment-related crises.

1 **Top requests:** Mobility repairs, home safety needs, medical stability, and essential living costs.

3 Average processing time: 5 days

2 78 out of 86 applicants received emergency assistance in 2025

4 Grants range from **\$100-\$500**

Scholarship Program: Provides college scholarships to the muscular dystrophy community

1 Scholarships Provided: **\$69,050**

3 Awarded a full scholarship to the first woman with SMA earning her Juris Doctorate at Yale Law School.

2 Awarded a housing scholarship to a young man attending UC Berkeley majoring in Political Science and minoring in Disability Studies and Public Policy.

4 Average yearly scholarship: **\$35,000**
